## The Golf Course



Spectacular, challenging and enjoyable to the final putt, since its opening the reputation and quality of The Kendleshire has attracted golfers from far and wide.

The three nines - Hollows, Ruffet & Badminton - contain more water than your average golf course and there are feature holes on each that will ensure every player will be talking about it at the end of the day. We often receive commendation from players expressing how well the course caters for every level of golfer.

Highlights of the Hollows are the dog leg par-4 fourth and the clubhouse-beckoning ninth over a short but tempting lake.

On the Ruffet the Sawgrass-inspired eleventh hole sees you teeing off to an island green on our five-acre lake, whilst the formidable sixteenth is renowned for endangering many a good scorecard.

The undulating greens of the Badminton demand a little thought before a willing approach, the deceptive twenty-first and finishing twenty-seventh being perfect examples of tough but memorable holes.

Regular visits by the County & England players and leading professionals, as well as the hosting of major competitions such as the County Championships in 2008 and the highly regarded Reid Trophy in 2009, speak volumes for the standard of the facilities. However, more than all of the above the number of repeat visits that we receive is the ultimate compliment.



All of the Kendleshire's greens are built to USPGA standard and are the foundation of the course's reputation.

To maintain their standard the club has always prevented metal shoes spikes and enforced a soft spikes only policy. This has paid rich dividends as far as maintaining the quality of the putting surfaces.

## The Facilities



We all appreciate the hard work and preparation that goes into a good round of golf. The Kendleshire is becoming a regional centre of excellence.

The Academy Course is a six hole, par three practice course. At 375 yards the course is ideal for any golfer; as a less-daunting introduction for the beginner, right through to an opportunity for the single-figure handicapper to hone their short game.

There are two putting greens, either side of the clubhouse. Built at the same time, and to the same standards, as the greens on the championship course, the putting greens show the same level of maturity, matching the conditions of the main greens to give you a valuable warm-up prior to your round.

The Practice Range is open throughout the year. Grass tees and a 275 yard landing area with target zones and flags combine to a popular facility. A "Dry Rainge" is located on the forward tee, allowing dry golfers wet-weather practice.

The club operates a large fleet of electric buggies. In Ryder Cup colours, blue or red, the fleet is available throughout the whole year. If you are playing a competition between two sides you have the option of playing the blues against the reds!

When playing the course you have the welcome sanctuary of the Halfway House, located in the middle of the course. This café provides hot & cold drinks, snacks and even food, with the ability to pre-order a couple of holes in advance.

Especially in the case of a Corporate or Charity day, you may wish to bring products, vehicles, signage and other marketing materials. There are a number of suitable locations across the clubhouse, patio and golf course for these to be displayed effectively and we will be happy to assist both in planning and placement on the day.

Although handicap certificates are not compulsory the Marshal will expect your last group to complete their round in four hours fifteen minutes, which means that your players must be regular golfers.

We are a [Soft Spike](#) Golf Course which means that you cannot play the course if you wear normal metal spikes. The Pro Shop will happily change your spikes for you, but please leave at least 30 minutes before your tee time. The Shop also stocks a wide range of golf shoes for sale.

All of our packages include a choice of main course from our A la Carte menu or, if you would prefer, the Carvery option is also available. As the organiser we require you to choose [one menu selection for your entire party](#) (excluding any special dietary requirements, which we can cater for on request). We will always do our best to ensure you eat on your own as a group.

Buggies are available throughout the year at £25 for 18 holes (£38 for 27 holes) and we would advise pre-booking if desired. Hire trolleys and electric hire trolleys are also available at £3 and £6 respectively.

## 'Golf in a Day' - for the golfer-in-the-making

### Typical Itinerary

#### 9:15 > Meet your Professional

Our Academy Professionals will greet you with coffee and biscuits on arrival, and give you an introduction to the game, guiding you through the day's activities.

#### 10:00 > Session One

**Putting:** learn the technique of putting. You will be guided through the setup, putting stroke and how to read the greens. Our aim is to teach you to consistently two-putt when we play the par-3 course in the afternoon. Also through the day you will learn the rules and etiquette on each topic covered.

**Chipping:** learn the art of chipping, from the edge of the green. Learn the technique, what clubs to use and some useful practice drills.

#### 11:15 > Session Two

**Pitching:** learn to pitch the ball high in the air to help you get close to the pin from around the green.



#### 12:30 > Lunch

Have lunch with the rest of your group in the clubhouse.

#### 1:30 > Session Three

**Bunkers:** learn to get your ball out of the bunker. The professionals will go through the setup and swing technique to help you lift that ball clear of the sand and onto the green. You will also get to learn a few bunker rules.

#### 2:30 > Session Four

**Long game:** now we are thinking big! Learn the correct setup and swing to hit irons and woods, allowing you to generate distance from your shots.

#### 3:45 > Break

Including coffee, tea and cake.

#### 4:00 > Session Five

**On the course:** you will get to play in a new player championship on our 6-hole Academy Course. There will be prizes at stake, so put your best swing forward and put all that you have learned during the day to practice.



If you organise a golf day, how many times have you invited someone - your best customer or client, for instance - only to find that they actually don't play golf?

How many times have you invited guests and their answer is that they only play once or twice per year?

Have you witnessed golfers coming off of the course having had a terrible round because they don't play enough?

Most people like to try something new and although golf can seem quite daunting to the non-player "Golf in a Day" is full of fun and gives everyone involved a sense of achievement. You might also end up with a client who will remember your invite forever more.

All of your guests arrive at the club and are welcomed together in the Clubhouse, whereupon the golfers go out to play the Championship Course and the non-golfers are introduced to the Professional staff.

The staff in our teaching Academy have put together a day schedule (shown left) that allows the 'would like to be' player as well as the part-time player the chance to experience a great day out and learn the basics of the game.

They also play in a tournament over our six-hole Academy Course at the end of the day to allow them to put into practice what they have learnt, before rejoining the golfers for your evening meal.

Throughout the course of the day your whole party (experienced golfers or otherwise) gets to make the most out of the Kendleshire, enjoy your hospitality and remember your day for a long time.
